RINSE-FREE DETERGENT CLEANER

GENERAL[®] has designed the K30 detergent for a wide range of applications. Ready to use (does not need to be diluted), it dissolves and removes the dirt in a single step. It is indicated for smooth, relatively non-absorbent surfaces and, in particular for GRES PORCELAIN TILES, GLASS, GLAZED or/and POLISHED SURFACES. The key feature of this detergent is that it is not foaming nor leaves little residue. It does not require rinsing and dries rapidly without leaving marks.

The total absence of aggressive substances make this product suitable for every day use.

FUNCTION

ALKALINE DETERGENT. Cleans, washes and dries without leaving marks.

INDICATION

Removal of all types of dirt. Particularly effective its degreasing capacity.

MATERIALS

FULLY VITRIFIED GRES PORCELAIN TILES, GLASS, CERAMICS, POLISHED MARBLE and GRANITE, MIRRORS, etc.

HOW TO USE

This is a ready-to-use product. Spray it onto the surface to be treated and let it act for a few minutes. Remove the dissolved dirt, wiping the treated surface with a clean cotton cloth.

Alternatively wet the cloth with the product and rub down the surface until it is perfectly clean.

THE PRODUCT DOES NOT REQUIRE RINSING.

COMPOSITION

Contains anionic and non ionic surfactants, sequestering agents mixture, glycolethers and polar substances.

TECHNICAL DATA

The product is ready-to-use; do not dilute. Consumption depends on the dirty of the surface.

NOTE

Alkaline, not-foaming detergent. It is suggested to wear impermeable gloves. More information by consulting the label or the Material Safety Data Sheet

IMPORTANT
